






INTERNATIONAL SCAFFOLDERS TRAINING







We recognise the need for employers to be <u>able to demonstrate evidence</u> of training and competence.

This scheme has been designed to provide a recognised training qualification for:

- Scaffolding Operatives
- Scaffolding Supervisors
- Scaffold Inspectors
- Others who need to raise their levels of skill, knowledge and awareness of access and Scaffolding.

The International Scaffolder scheme exists where no CISRS centres are in place. In most cases training and assessment can be carried out either at our training centres or on site at client's premises, providing they have suitable training facilities and equipment. Note that some of the more complex training, such as the Advanced Scaffolder, needs to be completed at our specially equipped scaffolder training centres.

Candidates who successfully pass our training courses will receive our International

Scaffolders Certificate and Cards.

International certificates and record cards are valid for 5 years from the date the training was completed.


Certificates and Record Cards can be renewed by completing a 2 Day scaffolding Update Course.

Certification, record cards & database All attendees that successfully complete our training courses will receive a certificate of achievement and a International Card as a demonstrable record of their training when on site.

They also agree to have their training records held on a central database that can be viewed by potential employers and clients to verify their personal training record.

We developed our website to provide secure access by clients and employers, to allow them to authenticate and verify training records online via our website.

In addition to the online verification and to further help overcome fraud and counterfeiting the training certificate has a unique certificate number, is printed with a photograph of the candidate and also their passport number.



INTERNATIONAL BASIC SCAFFOLDER

SCAFFOLD REFRESHER TRAINING & CARD RENEWAL

International Certificates and Record Cards expire after 5 years, to renew their certificates and cards holders need to attend a 2 day scaffolding refresher training course or progress to the next level of the scheme e.g. Basic Scaffolder to Intermediate Scaffolder.

Upon successful achievement of an International Scaffolder training course the delegate will automatically receive an updated Record Card endorsed with their training record on the back. The International Scaffolder Database will also be updated.

Level I

To renew this card the candidate must attend a further five days Level I course.

Candidate can only renew this card once only, at the next renewal they must move up to the Level 2 course.

Level 2

To renew this card the candidate must attend five days Level 2 refresher course.

Candidate can only renew this card once only, at the next renewal they must move up to the Level 3 course
